France's challenge with concepts that annoy : "islamo-gauchisme"

It is obvious that France has adopted a different stigmatization strategy in recent years with the desire to isolate the French Muslim community.

It is no longer a matter of reason to know what the numbers and the meanings of the concepts produced when we say "integration", "assimilation", "congregationalist", "jihadists", "terrorists" and "separatist Muslims".

Currently, France found itself in the lap of a new conceptual debate with the concept of "islamo-gauchisme" introduced by FrIIdIIrique Vidal, Minister of Higher Education, Research and Innovation.

This concept is not really new. "Islamo-gauchisme" (Islamic leftism) is a trend of thought that expresses the alleged affinity between left parties and Islamic circles.

It was popularized by the French far right. The concept experienced its first big boom in 2003, when it have been regularly used to silence opponents of the ban on religious symbols in French public schools. Since then, the concept has become popular among the far right and, according to philosopher Jean-Yves PranchIre, it has become

"a means of eliminating the defenders of human rights".

In her interview with CNews on February 14, 2021, Minister Vidal, who first introduced the concept, said that they opposed the Islamogauchisme thought movement that "gangrenous" French universities, and announced that she had asked an investigation by CNRS (National Scientific Research Center) to "evaluate all university research in France".

Another agenda that fueled the controversy was the announcement of the education assistant in Lyon on February 15 that a uniform "meatless" menu will be held in school canteens starting Monday, February 22. As a justification, the municipality cited the obligation to comply with the new health protocol imposed by the government.

Elected representatives of the right and center accused the predominantly Greens of the municipal government of trying to impose their vegetarian ideology. Of course, this has also been linked to the islamo-gauchisme, which is a current popular debate.

The municipality, which has prepared a meat-free menu, has been accused to keeping children away from pork or foods that are not suitable for halal food. Political science researcher Samuel Hayat stated in a column published by L'Obs in October 2020 that the concept of "Islamo-gauchisme" is "a scarecrow created to unite those who want to stigmatize Muslims, oppose the left and delegitimize social sciences".

From the writer Caroline Fourest to former Prime Minister Manuel Valls, the spectrum of those who use the concept is wide, including members of the National Front (far right party) and the philosopher Bernard-Henri LIVy. The government itself has used the term several times.

The Minister of Education, Jean-Michel Blanquer, condemned the "Islamo-gauchisme" movement that ravaged according to him the universities after the murder of Professor Samuel Paty.

Vidal said that the purpose of the research asked to the CNRS was to distinguish the line of "academic research and militancy". Goal; It is to take precautions by determining how much this concept is used for academic research purposes and how much it has tuned into an uncontrollable ideology movement group.

But, on the other hand, this desire has caused strong reactions in the academic world.

The University Rectors' Conference (CPU) added that this "concept does not exist", expressing "his surprise that the issue of Islamo-gauchisme within the university has caused a new debate". CNRS rated it as « don't have any scientific reality".





In addition, on February 20, more than 600 higher professors from the university world demanded the resignation of Minister Vidal in a column in the newspaper Le Monde, accusing him of **"raising the threat of intellec-tual repression" under the guise of the "Islamo-gauchisme"**.

Macron's France wants to make Muslims more isolated by constantly producing concepts, stigmatizing anyone who wants to stand on the slightest side of Muslims, or rather, bringing an objective, clear interpretation of the principle of secularism. Perhaps the main reason for this is to pave the way for a more dominant and unquestioned application of their own racist and separatist policies.

Another important reason why universities have been overtaken is that universities intensively conduct research on the colonial and racist history of France.

France is trying to demonizing the country's intellectuals who are in favor of human rights and freedoms and discharging them by accusing them with Islamic concepts which it invented.

Italy strikes full force in the east of the Democratic Republic of Congo with the murder of its ambassador Luca Attanasio

Early in the morning of 02/22/2021, there are bad news have circulated on social networks reporting the Assassination of His Excellency the Ambassador of Italy in Democratic Republic of Congo, in office 3 years ago years.

Hours later, the news have been confirmed by the Government of the Democratic Republic of Congo and by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Italy.

What really happened?

According to certain source, the Ambassador Italian LUCA ATTANA-SIO was assassinated by a rebel group not otherwise identified until then.

The facts took place 15 kilometers from the City of Goma, capital of the Province of North Kivu, a Zone red whose attacks are recurrent movements of rebels and highwaymen who operate on this section.

The attackers targeted a convoy of WFP (World Food Program) that the Ambassador conveyed for to distribute food products to the

population vulnerable victim of the war in eastern Congo, in the humanitarian framework.

According to some officials Congolese, the trip of the Italian Ambassador to the East Congo was not reported; and that the latter did not have requested any assistance from these authorities to ensure their safety and protection while on the move;

Even more, the real reason for the presence of Ambassador in the Red zone was ignored by these same authorities. (according to a statement official published). At the discretion of the members of the Minister of the Interior and the Minister of Foreign Affairs have indicated that the Ambassador did not come out officially to go to the East of the Republic Democratic of the Congo. This is the thesis that is supported by several military sources operating in this Zone Red.

Also referring to Stanis BUJAKIRA's Tweet, a Congolese journalist who tries to elucidate the cause of death and the circumstances which contributed to this Assassination, sufficiently demonstrates that things happened so quickly, which even prevented the military from intervening. He notes:

That the group left the city of Goma around 9 a.m., local time, around 10:15 a.m. local time.

WFP vehicles were stopped by an armed group, and all passengers were forced out of WFP vehicles, the driver driving one of the two vehicles, MUSTAPHA MILAMBO, was killed at this time.

The other six passengers were then forced to enter the surrounding bush under the threat of a firearm where there was an exchange of fire.

Certainly, this exchange was between the park warden Virunga and the Assailants, which led to the death of the Ambassador as well as those accompanying persons. On the other hand, to believe the second source which indicates that the Italian Ambassador has refused to comply with diplomatic rules which require that all official exits must be known to both national authorities; Provincials and Locales, Thus exposed themselves to danger which even the Congolese authorities are unable to contain.

This thesis appears to be real according to this source which starting from photos, images published on the internet where we saw the Ambassador in the mining zones by train to visit the mining sites where one exploits in a way artisanal minerals among other.

It was after this visit that he was shot dead.

Several questions arise, it is an act premeditated or an accident ?

Several revelations around this death. To believe a Tweet from Mr. Stanis BUSAKERA. Investigative journalist who attributes comments related to testimonies of his wife, the widow ZOKIA SEDDIKI to this term: "My husband LUCA was betrayed by someone who is us close, close to our family". Someone who knows his travels spoke, sold him and betraved him.

Starting from all his questions, it is necessary to initiate serious investigations in order to identify the perpetrators of these villainous acts and bring them before the competent courts.



This situation prompted the reaction of the international community because he is a diplomat who was brutally killed in eastern Congo; But I would like to remember that the eastern part of the Congo is at the risk of militias, rebel movement, foreign military forces operating without a glance of the community international, because everyone knows that the war in the East of Congo lasted over twenty years with over 7 million dead.

Despite some calls from society civilians in the face of all the large-scale killings and massacres the international community fails to invest in put in place such effective mechanisms to restore peace and safety in the great lake area.

The presence of the greatest mission of the Nations-United "LA MONUSCO" with more than 17,000 men did not resolve this problem and peace has not been brought back to the East. Conflict has destabilized the entire Great Lakes region.

It is time for the international community, international organizations to involve by putting effective mechanisms that can ensure that the peace and international security be restored.

A advocacy to the United Nations so that they act by voting a resolution of the Security Council in order to to apply Article 7 of the Charter of Nations United to incapacitate foreign forces and national is necessary to thus bring peace definitively to the Congo.
